TABI	LES AND BOOTH SPACE DESIGN
	VENDOR is responsible for bringing their own table and tent. NO TENTS OR TABLES WILL BE PROVIDED.
	BOOTH SPACE IS 10X10.
-	BOOTH RENTAL is \$5.00 per Saturday. More than one booth may be purchased if there is extra space available. Spaces will be offered first come first serve.
-	All tables must be a design that is stationary and allows the customers to pass safely. The use of milk crates, boxes and/or loose shelving is not acceptable and is not allowed at the market. The tables must be heavy and strong enough to sustain minor wind gusts.
PROI	DUCT(S) HANDLING. PRICING, SIGNAGE, ETC.
	Vendors are REQUIRED to use signage to distinguish their business. At the very least signage must list the name of the business.
Marie	Vendors (produce/food) MUST either display a permit from the State of TN or must display a sign stating that products in this booth are made in a domestic kitchen.
	PICKLED PRODUCTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BE SOLD IF BUSINESS DOES NOT HAVE A PERMIT FROM THE STATE OF TENNESSEE.
	All products must be labeled, legibly priced and located with the product sold.
	Product sampling is allowed but comes with restrictions. ALL samples must be given as a whole product. DO NOT cut, quarter, slice, etc. any product that is offered.
	All vendors (food/produce) must provide hand sanitizer and have it accessible to customers. The hand sanitizer MUST be used before and after a process.
	All items processed at the market must be sold the same day the product was processed. All processed foods must be in food grade containers at all times.
a Pitter and the designation of the second	All meat products must be stored in a temperature controlled environment. All products on display must be labeled "For Display Only", and cannot be sold.
	Vendor scales must be certified by the State of Tennessee and such certification must be placed on the scales. All produce must be free of large amounts of dirt/and or debris.
PART	ICIPANT AND ATTENDANT CONDUCT
	All persons shall present and conduct themselves in such a manner so as to not a negative impact on the market, the public, the Monroe County Health Council, the City of Madisonville, and/or other vendors.
	All persons shall refrain from the use of profanity and/or loud hawking to customers.
	All persons shall refrain from the use of alcohol, tobacco products or other illegal and/or controlled substances.
	All persons must wear shoes and shirts at all times.
	All children under the age of 12 MUST remain in the custody of a parent and/or guardian at all times. No children are allowed to play, roam, or wander throughout the market without adult supervision.
	No one shall engage in solicitation, collection drives, political or religious activities at the market
